



The State Fair Twilight Parade will take place on Thursday, August 12th at 5:30 p.m. All parade participants (those helping to carry the flag or walk with the group) must be at the staging area at 4 p.m. Our staging area will be near the Park Pavilion. We will be placed near the front of the parade just behind the Honor Guard (or thereabouts).

All participants must enter the staging area at the north entrance of Lincoln Park off of Sangamon Avenue. Vehicles NOT in the parade will not be allowed entrance into the park. Participants being dropped off will need to be dropped off outside of the park and then walk to their staging area. There will be absolutely no parking on the outside of Lincoln Park! Parking will be available for purchase in all Public Parking Areas at the Fairgrounds.


Candy and other distribution materials must be "handed" to spectators. Throwing to the fairgoers along the parade route is prohibited. Violators will be removed from the Parade!

A Message from Glenda Cassens: The Elks National Foundation (ENF) has kicked off the 2022 scholarship year. Here are the details!

Most Valuable Student (MVS) Contest:

The 2022 MVS application is officially begins August 2, 2021. Applications can be found online at enf.elks.org/MVS. The application deadline is November 15, 2021.

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) awards 500 fouryear scholarships based on academics, leadership, and financial need. National awards range from \$1,000 per year to \$12,500 per year. The national awards will announced in April 2022.

MVS scholarships are for students pursuing a fouryear degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), at a U.S. college or university next school year. Some important applicant details include:

- ★ Current high school seniors (or equivalent) who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.
- ★ Applicants do not have to be related to a member of the Elks.
- ★ Male and female students compete separately.

Legacy Awards – The Legacy Awards program begins on September 1, 2021. Legacy Awards provide \$4,000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elk members. The ENF offers a total of 350 national awards. The application deadline is February 7, 2022. Please visit enf.elks.org/Leg for more details and the application link.


