



Grand Union Flag • 1776

This month's calendar pays homage to the first national flag of the United States. Often referred to as the Grand Union Flag, Cambridge Flag, Continental Colour, and

First Navy Ensign, it was the de facto flag of the United States until 1777, when the 13 star U.S. flag was adopted by the Continental Congress. First hoisted aboard the newly converted 24-gun frigate Alfred in 1775, the field fea-




tured 13 alternating red and white stripes (representative of the Thirteen Colonies). The canton featured the King's Colour, to which the colonies belonged until July 1776.

These gift cards will help lower income & homeless veterans through the end of 2024 and into 2025.

Unfortunately, the number of low income and homeless veterans continues to grow. These gift cards will be used by SCVAC to purchase items needed such as personal hygiene products, bed linens, bath towels, toaster ovens, coffee makers, cooking utensils, pots and pans, toilet paper, laundry detergent, food, essential clothing, etc. The low income and homeless veterans' population needs daily support from our community.




